Excursions Information

Saint Naum monastery & Lake Ohrid springs guided tour

Monastery of St Naum is located on the south-east side of Lake Ohrid, close to the border with Albania, 28 km from the city of Ohrid respectively 38 km from the city of Struga. It is a stunning site, on a cliff high above the lake in the divine natural surroundings between the endless blue of Lake Ohrid and the high mountain range of Galichica. Saints Clement (840-916) and Naum (835-910) were native Macedonians. Both had been disciples of the brothers Cyril and Methodius, the inventors of the Glagolitic and Cyrillic scripts. Clement founded the Monastery of St Clement in Ohrid and invited his former fellow disciple Naum to help him teach the scriptures. Many pupils



passed through the monastery and the numbers became so demanding that Naum set up the Monastery of St Naum in 900, at the other end of Lake Ohrid.

Close to the monastery there are springs that feed Lake Ohrid with crystal waters flowing from Lake Prespa, situated at a higher elevation.

Trip to Saint Naum Monastery is by boat departing from the campsite or, in case of low lake water levels, from the Ohrid port located 10 km away. If sailing is not possible due to bad weather, the visit will take place by bus, departing from the camp at the scheduled time.

Boat trip's duration is approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes while by bus it is about 45 minutes.

Excursion to Sveti Jovan Bigorski monastery

Nestled on the picturesque slopes of Mount Bistra and overlooking the serene Radika River, the Monastery of Saint John Bigorski (Macedonian: Свети Јован Бигорски) stands as one of the most treasured spiritual and cultural landmarks of the Macedonian Orthodox Church. Located along the scenic Debar–Gostivar road in western Macedonia, 72 km from Struga, this centuries-old monastery is renowned not only for its religious significance but also for its breathtaking natural surroundings. Visitors are captivated by its rich history, exquisite wood-carved iconostasis, and the tranquil atmosphere that makes it a true jewel of Macedonian heritage.

Price: 45 € (transport, tourist guide and lunch)

Galichica National Park

In the southwestern part of Macedonia around 40 km from Struga, like a separator that divides Ohrid and Prespa Lake, the beautiful mountain Galichica extends. The National Park Galichica is a part of the mountain, and along with the city of Ohrid and the lake, it was placed under the protection of UNESCO.



From the National Park Galicica stretch the stunning views of the Ohrid Lake and Prespa Lake. It is especially attractive for visitors to observe the two beautiful lakes at the same time. The landscape attractive, aesthetic and rare values also apply to the mountain characteristics Galicica owns.

The terrain has a large presence of relict plants, with 11 plant species that can be found only at this site, and 26 endemic animal species are registered. This is due to the large amount of rain during the year. Especially striking is the number of butterflies - 1644 species in such a small area.

Venue site

Camping AS is located on the shore of Lake Ohrid, just 3,7 kilometers east from the center of city of Struga, with capacity of 1000 campers. It has 12 fully furnished bungalows and space for tents and trailers. It has its own restaurant and sports facilities. The camp is an ideal place to enjoy nature and with all the amenities you can feel at home.
