Reg. 4 Entry Fee

The entry fee is fixed by the organiser: **200 Euros (€)** (See Art. 4 of Category 1.3 “FIM Rendez-Vous Meritum” of the CTG).

Children between the ages of 8 and 12 will pay 50% of the adult entrance fee. Children under the age of 8 will be admitted free of charge.

- If the organiser should accept entries made at the venue of the meeting, a surcharge of 25% **will be** imposed. Prior vacancy check with Organiser is advised

Reg. 5 Closing date for entries

The deadline for the entries and the booking of the accommodation is **31st March 2026**.

The number of participants is limited to **200** persons.

Reg. 7 Accommodation

100% of accommodation fee will be paid with the registration.

Reg. 9 Results and Classification

The FIM Rendez-Vous Meritum meeting is an international meeting of friendly character, which is reserved for a particular group of participants, so there is no classification.

Reg. 10 Cancellation of event

In accordance with the CTG the Organiser can cancel the event:

- if, at the closing date, the number of entries is below **70 persons**
- in the case of absolute necessity.

In the case of cancellation of the meeting, the participants who transmitted their entry forms before the closing entry date will be notified, and the registration payments will be returned in full (money transfer cost paid by Organiser)

Reg. 11 General

Cancellation of registration:

in case of cancellation of registration, the participant shall transmit it to the Organiser

- until 31st March 2026 100 % of the registration fee will be refunded.
- between 1st April 2026 and 29th April 2026 25 % of the registration fee will be refunded.
- after 30th April 2026 no refund is possible

NOTE: Refund of the costs will be reduced by bank transfer fees (SHA for EU)

Supplementary Regulations:

Disqualifications

Participants shall be officially disqualified at the discretion of the Executive Committee if necessary.

Reg. 12 Liability of the Authorities, Organisers and Participants

Reg. 13 Rider Conduct and Protection of the Environment

Participants of the FIM Rendez – Vous Meritum are motorcyclist ambassadors for their country and are expected to consider other road users in accordance with Art. 3 of the General Part of the CTG.

Recommendations to Road Users:

- a) Individual motorcyclists should develop riding habits to ensure full integration with other types of road users.
- b) Ride safely and avoid aggressive and competitive riding.
- c) Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines.
- d) Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency.
- e) Noise annoyance. Use a standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level.
- f) Use only routes which are open to motorcyclists.
- g) Ride like a professional by riding at a quiet and unobtrusive pace when riding in groups.
- h) Respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery.
- i) Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently.
- j) Ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled.
- k) Encourage a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles
- l) Remember that our cities and our roads are not circuits
